

2014 PDP League Information Sheet



General Information

- This is a 12 week competitive 9-hole stroke play league. League play will be held starting any time after 1:00 PM every Thursday. Pre-season runs from May 1 – May 29 with the regular season starting on June 5 continuing through August 21. League championship will be held on Saturday August 23. All current PDP cardholders are eligible to play in the league.
- The cost to participate in the weekly competitions will be \$16 to ride and \$9 to walk. A portion of this will be used towards weekly prizes with the remaining balance being allocated to year end prizes.
- The league will include the use of handicaps, established during the month of May, (minimum of 3 scores needed) when finalizing each week's winners. If you participated in the PDP League during 2013 and had a valid handicap on file, it will stay the same for the beginning of this year. **Please note: League Administrators possess the right to intervene and make any adjustment to players' handicap that they see fit.*

League Setup

- There will be two (2) separate divisions: the Pro's Division and the Joe's Division.
 - 1. The Pro's Division**
 - This division is for higher caliber players looking for a tough competition.
 - Players have the option to tee off from the **GOLD** tees or the **BLUE** tees. Players will designate their tee choice on their scorecard each week.
 - 2. The Joe's Division**
 - This division is for players of all abilities looking for a more relaxed atmosphere and competition.
 - Players have the option to tee off from the **WHITE** tees or the **GREEN** tees. Players will designate their tee choice on their scorecard each week.

**Please note: Do not choose a tee based on your desire to win but based on your playing ability and what can provide the most appropriate challenge. In certain cases, the committee has the right to intervene on tee selections. Players have the option of choosing what division to play in prior to June 5. However, there will be NO switching divisions once the regular season starts.*

Scoring

- Each week will be worth 100 total points (per division). The point distribution will be based on each players score and finish with first place receiving the most points.
- The championship will be worth 500 total points (per division).
- In order to qualify for any Grand Prize, a player must play in at least 6 weekly competitions (from June 5 – August 21).
- Handicaps will be re-evaluated on a monthly basis and may change depending upon posted scores.
- Rankings will be determined based off of weekly net scores. All weekly ties will be broken via scorecard playoff. All season ties will be broken based on participation.

Prizes*

- Weekly Prizes will be handed out in the form of gift cards to the top 1st place gross and net, per division, each week as well as closest to the pin winners.
 - Year End Prizes will be awarded in the form of gift cards to the top three finishers per division (as of August 21).
 - Championship Prizes:
 - The top three (3) winners in **each division** will receive a grand prize after the championship..
 - Grand prizes may include merchandise (clubs, bags, balls, etc), gift cards or 12 months PDP privileges.
- *Note: All prizes will be based on participation and may vary from those above and on a weekly basis.*

Competition Rules Sheet

Governing Body

- All play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions will be settled by the League Administrators, whose decision is final.
 - **The one ball rule will NOT be used for this competition.**
- Players will be allowed to lift, clean and place their ball in their own fairway. All other shots must be played as they lie.
- Players must putt out on all holes; there are **NO "GIMMEES."**

Out of Bounds

- With the exception of public roads, all "OB" areas will be marked by a white stake.
- Public roads are considered "OB" but may or may not be marked by white stakes. To further clarify, a ball is considered out of bounds regardless of whether the ball comes to rest across the road on another hole.

Hazards

- All lakes on the course are marked by red paint and are considered *lateral hazards*. If a player's ball is hit into the lake, they may proceed under Rule 26.

Wooded Areas

- Multiple holes on the golf course contain wooded areas that are not marked as hazards. For example, the left side of hole #3 and the left side of hole #13. If you believe that your ball has landed in this area, *please hit a provisional before going to look*. This will help speed up play tremendously.

Questions

- If there are any questions, on the course, about a ruling, or how to proceed in play of a hole, please play two balls and finish the hole.
 - Play the first ball as it lies and the second under your interpretation of the rule. Record *both* scores and bring scorecard to committee for proper interpretation of the rules.

Other Rules

- Players are required to play with at least one other player for scoring purposes. This player does not have to be in the PDP League.
 - Results from each week will be posted on the results board by Monday of the following week, and prizes will be ready for pick-up the following Monday as well.
